



SCHOOL DIRECT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION

- Candidates must hold a GCSE A*-C or equivalent in Mathematics and English
- Candidates wishing to teach at Primary level or science based subjects at Secondary level must also have achieved GCSE A* - C in Science
- Candidates must hold a bachelor's degree (class 2:1 or above), or an approved non-UK qualification
- Candidates holding a bachelor's degree below class 2:1 would be considered where the candidate can demonstrate additional qualifications and professional experience

FURTHER REQUIREMENTS

- If you have non-UK qualifications, you will need a [Statement of Comparability](#) from [UK NARIC](#)
- After a successful interview, you will need to pass the Professional Skills Tests in Literacy and Numeracy before training begins
- After a successful interview, you will need to undertake a minimum of ten [school experience](#) days in UK state mainstream schools
- Passing of a DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check
- Some candidates may also be required to complete a [Subject Knowledge Enhancement](#) course prior to training. All requirements must be met in advance of commencing training.
